UCSF MAINTENANCE OF CERTIFICATION PART IV APPROVAL PROGRAM (MOCAP) 2019 ANNUAL REPORT


The UCSF MOC 4 Approval Program (MOCAP) is an approved sponsor of the American Board of Medical Specialties Multi-Specialty Portfolio Program (MSPP) with authority to award Maintenance of Certification Part 4 (MOC4) credit to UCSF physicians for their participation in quality, performance, and process improvement activities. Eighteen of the 24 medical specialty boards participate in the ABMS MSPP. UCSF MOCAP has engaged medical center leadership and staff, physician faculty, and GME learners to assist in promoting a culture of continuous performance improvement as well as streamline administrative and business processes.


QUALITY REVIEW BOARD (QRB)


The QRB provides expert review and analysis to ensure project structure and documentation meet ABMS MOC4 requirements. Additionally, the QRB provides education and guidance to departments and physician leaders regarding MOC4 requirements for QI projects. Members include physician quality improvement leaders from 11 UCSF departments and divisions as well as housestaff representatives.

OUTCOMES

In 2019, we approved 30 projects from 9 departments and 25 clinical divisions and awarded MOC4 credit to 625 participants. Although the American Board of Orthopedic Surgery and American Board of Plastic Surgery withdrew from participation in the program, we were able to secure an agreement to maintain credit approval for members of these boards participating in projects that were already submitted. The following graphics illustrate MOCAP's growth since its inception.







INNOVATIONS AND HIGHLIGHTS



UCSF Health's Value Improvement – After piloting two projects with UCSF Health's Value Improvement Program in 2018, we expanded our collaboration to approve 10 projects and award 82 physician participants with MOC4 credit. The Value Improvement Program is comprised of initiatives that yield financial value by improving processes, systems, and daily work.

Continuing Alignment with Benioff Children's

Hospital Oakland (BCHO) - We worked to solidify and expand our collaboration with BCHO. We approved several projects that were based at or included physicians from BCHO. Our largest projects were "Standardized Approach to Pediatric Appendicitis" led by Brian Lee, MD and "BCHO Asthma, Immunizations, Depression/ Developmental Screening initiatives" led by Lee Atkinson-McEvoy, MD.
